Project Environment

Constanta is the fifth most populous city in Romania with 283,872 inhabitants. It is situated in the south-east of Romania. Here you will see many groups of ethnic minorities: Bulgarians, Turks, Tatars, Germans, Greeks, Russians, Armenians, Romani (about 17%). Its historical monuments, ancient ruins, museums and shops, and proximity to beach resorts make it the focal point of Black Sea coast tourism. Throughout the year, cultural activities are organized by: "Oleg Danovski" Opera and Ballet Theatre, Constanța National Theatre, Elpis Puppet Theatre, House of Culture.

The reality in Constanța is that several local events, with a very diverse range of interest, are cancelled due to the lack of interest of Constanța community. E.g. training courses, shows for kids, fests for food and drinks, seminars for EU funds, even dance shows. Many young people show a low level of engagement and responsiveness to extracurricular activities. The absence of role models to develop the critical and analytical skills of youth affects the personal development of each individual as well as the entire community.

Practical Information

Accommodation: The volunteers will live in shared bedrooms with common area, shared cooking, washing, laundry and social facilities, free wi-fi.

Pocket and Food money: Volunteers will receive a monthly food allowance of 150 Euro to buy food products and cook for themselves and 90 Euro as “pocket money”.

Local Transport: The bus tickets will be reimbursed weekly.

Holidays: Volunteers will work 6 hours per day, 5 days a week, two consecutive days off per week .

Travel: The travel costs will be reimbursed according to the distance band.
