We divide our work in three working poles that constantly cooperate and collaborate with each other.

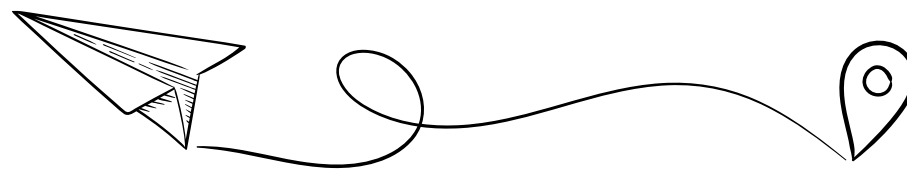

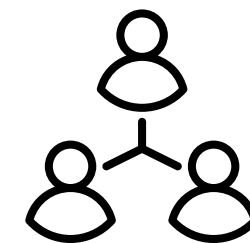

Collaborate in the mission of our association Bokra Sawa.

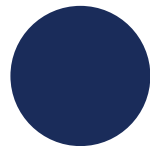

Assist and ensure the smooth implementation of European funded initiatives, allowing for effective collaboration and cross-border engagement.



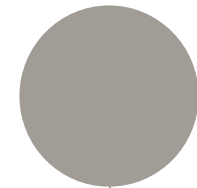

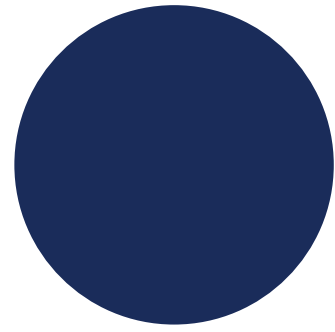


How to get to Marseille ?

You have several transport options to get to Marseille. You can come by plane, train or bus. It is crucial to keep the invoices of all the purchases in order to guarantee the reimbursement of your travel costs.

Keep in mind your budget for travel costs and never buy a ticket without our previous confirmation.



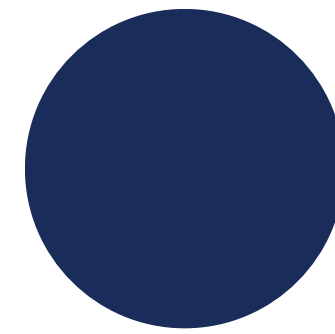
By plane. *Par avion.*

The closest airport to Marseille is the Marseille-Provence airport (MRS).

Once you arrive to the airport, you can take an airport shuttle that goes directly to the central station Marseille Saint Charles.

You can buy the bus ticket in the airport. The price of the ticket is 7€ if you are under 25 and 10€ if you are over 25. Every fifteen minutes a bus leaves for Marseille Saint Charles and the journey takes about 30 minutes (depending on traffic).

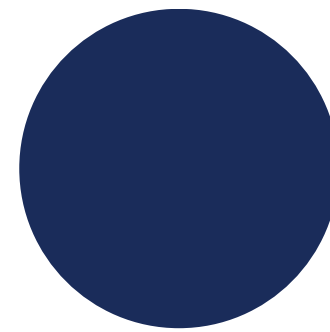
Once you arrive to Marseille Saint Charles station, a member of our team will come and pick you up to take you to your accommodation.



By train. *En train.*

The Marseille-Saint-Charles train station is a major railway hub in the city, well-connected to other French cities and neighboring countries.

By bus. *En bus.*

FlixBus and BlaBlaBus are popular international and long-distance bus operators that offer routes to Marseille from various European cities. The bus station in Marseille is located near the Saint-Charles train station, making it easily accessible.

Allowance.

At the beginning of each month, you will receive an allowance in order to cover the cost of food and pocket money.

We suggest to open a bank account in France to ease up the monthly payment process. The transport costs inherent to the mission are covered.



Language Support.

If your mission is longer than two months, you will have access during your volunteering to an Online Language Support provided by Erasmus+. Additionally, we can offer you free french courses provided by our local partners, subject to availability.

Health.

You will be entitled to health insurance during your mission provided by European Solidarity Corps. In case you are a resident of a EU country, you will need to bring your European Health Card to France. This way, you will have access to the french health system.

Communication.

We understand the importance of staying connected during your time in Marseille. Having a local phone line number will not only make it easier to stay connected with us and fellow volunteers but also allows you to stay in touch with your loved ones. Once you arrive, we can guide you in order to choose a french phone line offer that suits your needs.



Where are you going to live ?

You will have your own private bedroom in a shared apartment, which you will be sharing with two other international volunteers.

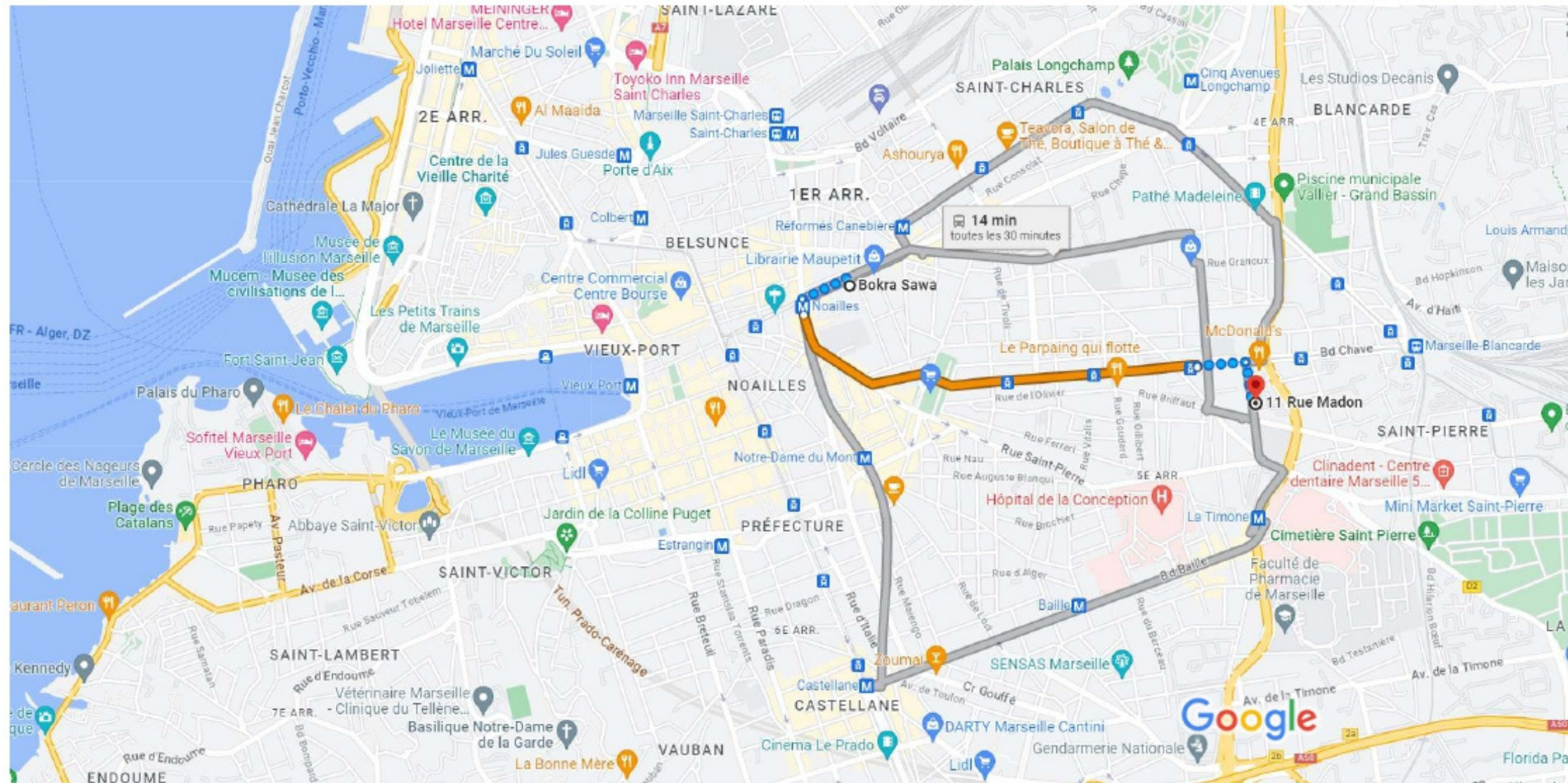
The apartment is fully furnished and includes a shared bathroom, kitchen, and living room that you will all use together.

Your private bedroom comes with essential bedding such as sheets, a pillow, and a blanket. It also features a desk with a lamp, providing you with a designated study space. Additionally, there is a spacious wardrobe for your belongings.

Please keep in mind that you should bring your own towel, as it will not be provided by the accommodation.

The apartment is situated at 11 Rue Madon, 13005 Marseille.

It is located in a neighborhood called Le Camas in the 5th arrondissement of Marseille.

Le Camas is known as a residential neighborhood while still being within easy reach of the city center

To reach the office of Bokra Sawa from the apartment, you can conveniently do so by taking Tram (T1). The tram ride is approximately 12 minutes long and will get you to our office.

In case of an activity implementation during the weekend or after working hours, you will have the right to rest hours/days in compensation.

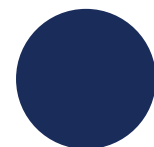
At the end of your mission.
